Annual General Meeting

November, 2021



- > Covid still impacted what we were allowed to do
- Biggest covid impact was not having school tournaments
- ➤ No known cases of covid linked to baseball again in 2021
- > A return to tournaments, Provincials and Atlantics



- ➤ Program enhancements 9U Minor and Major, new 17U division, new 21U team (BNL decision to have 21U female as part of the Minor division)
- ➤ Registration 982 9% increase vs 2020; 3% increase vs 2019
- ➤ A strong performance by all All-Star teams at provincials 11U AAA and A Gold; 13U AAA, AA & A Gold; 14U AA Gold; 15U AAA, AAA and A Gold; 16U AA & A Gold; 21U Gold



- ➤ Good performances at Atlantics especially at 15U and 13U AAA
- ➤ Successfully hosted 13U AAA Atlantics
- > Piloted an 11U house league ranking night
- Continued Skills and Drills camps restarted in 2020
- > Continued High Performance Program with PSA



- ➤ Hosted 16U, 15U AA/A and 11U AAA/AA provincials
- ➤ Hosted the 2nd Annual Mike Buist Classic
- > Developed additional resources for all-star coaches
- ➤ Reinstated mid-season tournaments in 15U, 17U and 18U and continued Hit, Run and Throw weekends in other divisions
- Continued Specialty Camps



- > Rolled out new sponsorship packages
- Achieved a large surplus due to one-time special grants to deal with covid
- Continued and improved processes and transparency around all star team selections
- Reviewed our fee structure for most activities

- ➤ Some instances where coaches were not following proper protocols (9U especially concerning)



PRIORTIES FOR 2022

- > Re-launch and re-examination of school tournaments
- Development of a new SJMBA logo and new medals
- Assessment of infrastructure priorities including a scoreboard for Edgar Hartery Memorial field (LSP), office storage space, lights for batting cages, piloting a portable scoreboard, and a scorer's hut at APH.



PRIORTIES FOR 2022

- Consideration of program changes "post"-covid gear bags, spectator viewing areas, tournaments/Hit, Run & Throw
- > Examination of all-star inter-league playoffs/final tournament
- > Player/parent awareness re: all-star pickups for Atlantics
- > Continuing to grow female baseball
